## **AWARD-WINNING WESTERN ENTERTAINER R.W. HAMPTON IN CONCERT** **AT THE OLD MILL THEATER IN BUHLER, KS 10/19-20/07**

Residents of Reno County and visitors to south-central Kansas alike have a rare opportunity to enjoy the music of award-winning Western entertainer **R.W. HAMPTON** when the Cimarron Sounds recording artist appears in concert at the Old Mill Theater in Buhler, KS on Friday and Saturday, October 19 and 20, 2007. Hampton's solo acoustic performance will feature material from his wide ranging catalog and spotlight songs from his brand new Cimarron Sounds CD, **OKLAHOMA – Where The West Remains**.

A ranch-owning resident of Miami, New Mexico, Hampton can be counted among America's foremost Western entertainers. His wonderfully rich baritone voice has been captured on eleven CDs to date, including two cowboy gospel CDs, one Christmas collaboration and his latest album, which was recorded with the Enid, OK Symphony Orchestra to commemorate Oklahoma's 2007 Statehood Centennial. But Hampton is more than just a gifted cowboy singer: he has a multi-faceted career, one that has seen him perform in a dozen Western movies, co-write and star in the one-man play, *The Last Cowboy*, narrate several national radio and TV spots, serve as the subject of a number of national print advertising campaigns and emcee several significant Western awards events. All this on top of being recognized nine times by various Western associations for his singing and songwriting. In 2006 alone Hampton was named Male Vocalist of the Year by the Academy of Western Artists (AWA) and his song, *For The Freedom*, from his last CD, *I Believe*, was voted Song of the Year by the Western Music Association (WMA).

Hampton has a quality of genuineness about him that resonates when he's on stage, in person, or just through the words of his songs. For Hampton has lived what he sings about on ranches all over the American west, and the world of early mornings, hard work, rough horses, maverick cattle and new ranges fits him. After twenty years in the entertainment business, Hampton is still pure cowboy, singing about what he knows and loves best.

The Old Mill Theater is located at 111 Old Mill Lane in Buhler, KS. Tickets for Hampton's concerts on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> are \$32.00 and include admission and a delectable barbecue dinner.
